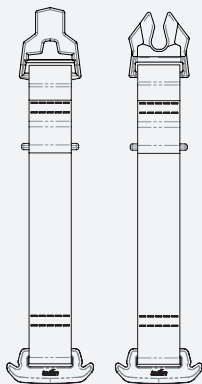

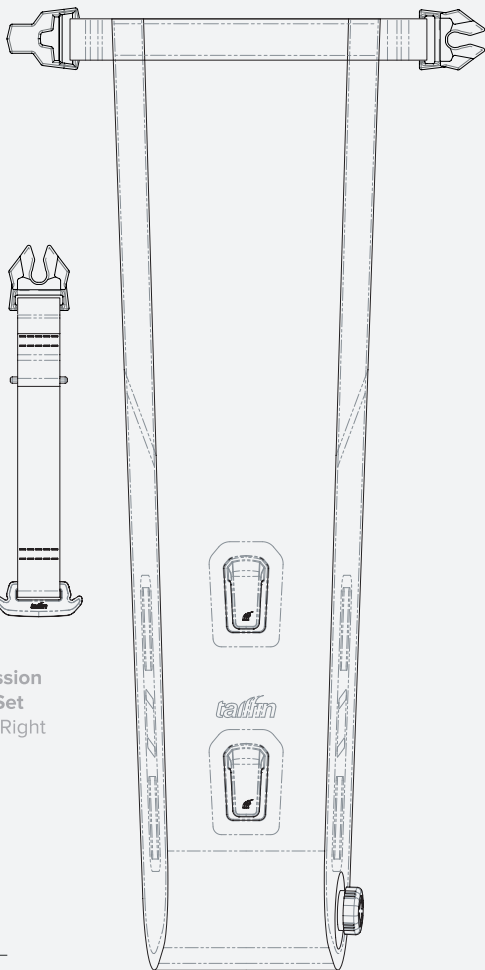

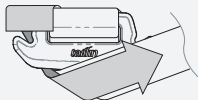

Assembly Instructions

Step One Choose Strap Set-Up

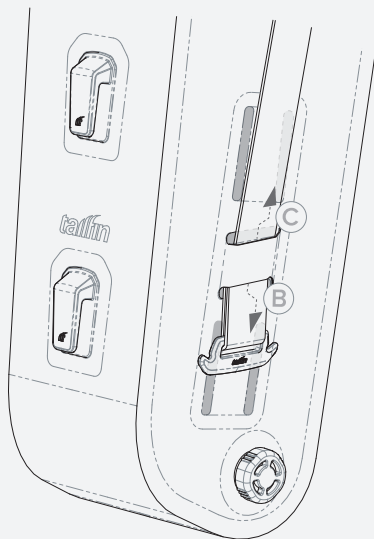
To fit optional Compression straps:

- (A) Fold webbing over Tailfin T hook*.



*How to fold compression strap for easier install.

- (B) Once folded, push through horizontal side slots.
- (C) Pull tight to set in position.



Option A

No Compression Straps

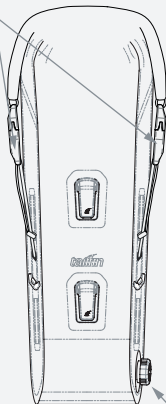
Close bag with single clip at the top of the bag for the simplest setup. No Compression Straps needed.



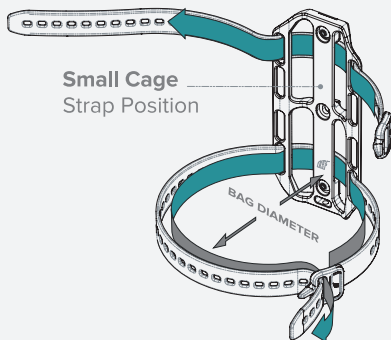
Option B

2x Side Compression Straps

Fit two Compression Straps to horizontal side slots, roll bag and connect clips at side to streamline and compress contents.

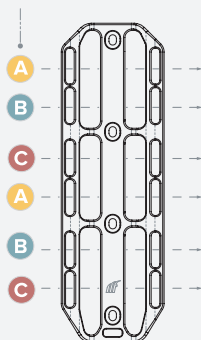


Use Air Valves to remove air and aid compression.

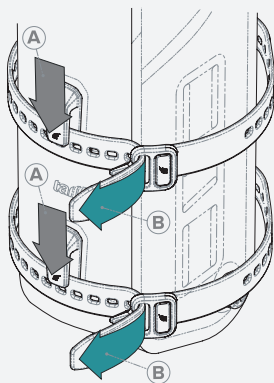


Step Two Thread Cargo Strap through Cargo Cage (as shown above) and back through the Cargo Strap hook. Leave a wide enough diameter to fit the bag.

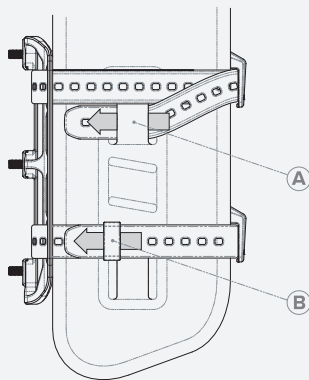
Large Cage Strap Positions



For a Large Tailfin Cargo Cage, set the Cargo Straps at four slots apart so that they align with the hooks on the front of the Cage Pack.



Step Three (A) Slide bag into position and lower the bag hooks onto the straps. (B) Tighten Cargo Straps around Cage Pack.



Step Four To hold the loose end of the Cargo Strap. Either (A) Use the bags side slots or (B) Use the Cargo Strap Keeper.
